- Board Operators are responsible for helping to get live broadcast events on and off the air from the studio location. Live broadcast events primarily include high school sports broadcasts and broadcasts from community events or local businesses.
- Board Operators ensure connection from the studio sound board to broadcasters on location is successfully made, that all commercials play as scheduled, and that a return to regularly scheduled programming is made at the conclusion of the broadcast.
- Hours are primarily weeknights, Saturdays and Saturday nights during high school sporting events for sporting events and on other on locations broadcasts on V1047 . An average weeknight shift lasts approximately 3 hours, with Saturday games and/or tournament times typically having longer shifts. Normally the heaviest hours will be during the sports season from August – May, with much lighter summer schedules. However in Winter/Spring 2021, the changes in the schedules will require heavier hours in what might typically be lighter work schedules in a normal year.
- Applicants must be reliable, self-disciplined to show up on time, have reliable transportation to and from work, be comfortable with computers and technology. No previous job experience is required. Students are welcome to apply as long as they are 16 years of age or older.
